Nursery Visit to Stockton Fire Station – Friday 17 March

Nursery children will be visiting Stockton Fire Station on Friday 17 March as part of their topic on 'Super Heroes'. The children will explore the Fire Station and Fire Engine. The children will depart school at 9.20am (walking) and will return to school for 11.30am.

For the trip the children will need the following items:

- Trainers with good grips or wellington boots (depending on the weather)
- Warm socks
- School uniform
- Waterproof coat (school coat)

Mr Barnbrook-McKay will lead the visit and will be accompanied by other nursery staff and parent volunteers. If you are able to volunteer, please complete the slip below and return to Mr Barnbrook-McKay via the school office. Pupils are covered under the School's insurance policy. A full risk assessment has been undertaken by the leader. A qualified first aider will be accompanying the trip. There is no cost for this visit. Please could you ensure that the appropriate medication is given to Mr Barnbrook-McKay on the day if your child suffers from asthma or severe allergic reactions, as without this they will not be allowed to go on the trip. Pupils are expected to demonstrate excellent behaviour at all times and to follow instructions given by the accompanying adults and centre staff. Please note: if the duty crew are called out for an incident the trip will be stopped and the children will walk back to Nursery.
