Year 3 Trip to Roseberry Topping

As you will recall our planned trip to Roseberry Topping in September was postponed. On Tuesday 9 May (or in case of inclement weather Tuesday 16 May) the children will be undertaking a 'day expedition' to Roseberry Topping during which they will record wind speed and temperature, study flora and fauna, draw field sketches, practise survival techniques, as well as climb Roseberry Topping. We shall depart on the school minibuses at 9.15am and return to school for 3.30pm.

A packed lunch will be supplied by school. The children will also need the following items:

Trainers with good grip or walking boots. (Please do not buy boots specifically for the trip)
Sports socks
Trousers
Shirt
Sweatshirt / fleece
Cagoule / waterproof coat
Over trousers
Day sack
Sun hat / hat / gloves depending on the weather forecast
Once a-day sun screen (to be applied at home in the morning)
A healthy snack and a diluted drink or water

The total cost for this trip will be £5. A qualified first aider will accompany the trips. Pupils are expected to demonstrate excellent behaviour at all times and to follow instructions given by accompanying adults. Pupils are covered under the School's insurance policy and a full risk assessment has been undertaken by the group leaders. A qualified first aider will be present. Mr Haywood will lead the trip and will be accompanied by Miss Thompson and Miss Thomas.

Please ensure that you have notified School of any changes to your contact numbers and any new medical conditions for your child and ensure any inhalers/medications are given to your child's teacher to take on the trip.
