### Y5 Eden Camp Trip – 21 June 2017

Year 5 pupils will visit Eden Camp on Wednesday 21 June 2017. The pupils will explore various exhibits such as 'the Blitz', 'the home front' and 'the U-boat menace' to support their learning in our history topic about the Second World War.

The cost of the trip will be £4 and this will be added to your school bill. Pupils will leave school at 8.45am and return to school at approximately 3.50pm to be collected as normal at the end of the school day. We will travel to and from the venue on the school minibuses. Parents will be informed if the return time changes.

Pupils should wear full school PE kit (tracksuit bottoms, school hoodie, outdoor trainers and waterproof coat). A packed lunch will be provided. However, pupils can bring extra snacks for the journey if they wish, but no chewing gum should be brought and drinks must be in a re-sealable plastic bottle only.

There will be an opportunity to visit the gift shop at the museum. We would ask that pupils bring no more than £5.

I will lead the trip and will be on hand to supervise the pupils throughout the day. A full risk assessment has been completed. The trip will be subject to the conditions as set out in the Parent Contract, and will be covered by the school's insurance policy. Staff will take a first aid kit with them, and there are additional first aid facilities on site. **If your child suffers from asthma or severe allergic reactions please ensure their inhaler/medication/epipen is with them. If they do not have them, they will be unable to go on the trip.**

**Pupils are allowed to bring personal items such as mobile phones in order to keep in touch with parents; however, these items will be taken at their own risk.** We will endeavour to take photographs on as many school trips as possible.
