The Eurotalk Junior Language Challenge 2017

I am writing to ask your permission for your son/daughter to take part in an exciting national competition called the Junior Language Challenge. This knock-out competition consists of three rounds.

For the first round each pupil will learn French using activities on the Eurotalk website. Pupils will be able to access activities on both tablets and computers (including iPads and Android) and there is a JLC app available to download from the App Store. Pupils will cover many different topics such as greetings, numbers and telling the time. Each time they complete an activity they will acquire points. The top 30 pupils from the area will then go forward to the semi-final, held locally in September.

The top three pupils in each region then go forward to the final in London. Last year we were incredibly successful and had two pupils representing Red House competing at Olympia. Both pupils performed brilliantly. In addition there were some fabulous prizes awarded to the top performers for all their efforts.

Eurotalk, the company organising the event, support a charity called 'One Billion' which aims to ensure that children in developing countries reach their potential in maths, reading and English. Eurotalk has asked for an entrance fee of £5 per pupil, which will be donated to this charity. This is the only fee regardless of how successful your child is.

This is a fantastic opportunity for your child to get a taste for lifelong language learning and build on their French already learnt in school.
