Visit to the Holocaust Education Centre, Newark – 26 June 2017

Year 8 pupils, and those pupils in Year 9 who have opted to study GCSE History, will visit the Holocaust Education Centre on Monday 26 June 2017. The National Holocaust Centre allows pupils to explore the history and implications of the Holocaust. Pupils will visit the memorial garden and two permanent exhibitions: The Holocaust Exhibition and The Journey. Both exhibitions house artefacts from the period and pupils will meet a survivor of the Holocaust and listen to their story.

The cost of the trip will be £20 and this will be added to your Autumn Term account. Pupils will leave school at 7.45am; please meet at school at 7.30am so that we are ready for our departure at 7.45am. We will return to school at approximately 6:00pm. We will travel to and from the Holocaust Education Centre by coach.

Pupils should wear school uniform. A packed lunch will be provided. However, pupils can bring extra snacks for the journey if they wish, but no chewing gum should be brought and drinks must be in a re-sealable plastic bottle only.

There will be an opportunity to visit the gift shop at the museum. We would ask that pupils bring no more than £10.

I will lead the trip and will be on hand to supervise the pupils throughout the day. A full risk assessment has been completed. The trip will be subject to the conditions as set out in the Parent Contract, and will be covered by the school's insurance policy. Staff will take a first aid kit with them, and there are additional first aid facilities on site. If your child suffers from asthma or severe allergic reactions please ensure their inhaler/medication/epipen is with them. If they do not have them, they will be unable to go on the trip.
