The Eurotalk Junior Language Challenge 2018

I am writing to ask your permission for your son/daughter to take part in an exciting national competition called the Junior Language Challenge. This knock-out competition consists of three rounds.

For the first round each pupil will learn Spanish using activities on the Eurotalk website. Pupils will be able to access activities on both tablets and computers (including iPads and Android) and there is a JLC app available to download from the App Store. Pupils will cover many different topics such as greetings, numbers and colours. Each time they complete an activity they will acquire points. The end of round 1 is in June 2018. At this time, the top 30 pupils from the area will be selected to go forward to the semi-final, held locally in September.

For the semi-final, pupils will be given a new language to learn. The top three pupils in each region then go forward to the final in London. Last year we were incredibly successful and had three pupils representing Red House competing at The Language Show at the Business Design Centre. All three pupils performed brilliantly. In addition there were some fabulous prizes awarded to the top performers for all their efforts.

Eurotalk, the company organising the event, support a charity called 'One Billion' which aims to ensure that children in developing countries reach their potential in maths, reading and English. Eurotalk has asked for a registration fee of £5 per pupil, which will be donated to this charity. This is the only fee regardless of how successful your child is.

This is a fantastic opportunity for your child to get a taste for lifelong language learning and build on their language skills already learnt in school.
