As you are aware, we exchanged contracts for the sale of Chesterfield House some time ago. The sale was subject to planning and I'm delighted to be able to inform you that planning has now been approved and we should be completing the sale in the coming weeks. This will allow us to continue our refurbishment programme on both sides of the pond. During the summer we intend to undertake the following projects:

Junior School

- Create an outdoor classroom
- Create a new Learning Resource Centre, including investment in new computers
- Refurbish the top floor of the Vicarage for Year 4
- Refurbish the Library to create a 'Zen Den' reading space in conjunction with the PTA
- Redecoration of the entrance to make it more welcoming

Senior School

- Extend the Design Technology Classroom
- Create a new locker room for the senior boys
- New computers and ICT

Further work in the Senior School will take place in the coming months when the work can be programmed in. This will include:

- A new floor in the Sports Hall
- Refurbishment of the Science Labs

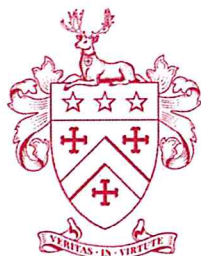
School Council is determined to provide excellent facilities to match our exceptional teaching.
