All parents and grandparents are invited to join us for the Harvest Service.

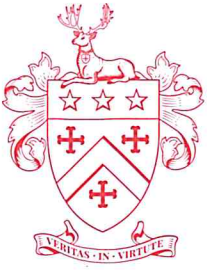
