### **Year 6 Residential Trip to Carlton Camp: Friday 22 – Sunday 24 March 2019**

Your child has the opportunity to take part in a 3 day/two night residential trip to Carlton Camp in the North Yorkshire Moors. The proposed trip would take place on Friday 22 – Sunday 24 March 2019 (however the dates are only provisional until a firm booking is made). The itinerary of the trip is designed to give pupils a taste of a variety of adventurous activities such as archery, den building and 'weaseling' in a safe environment under the supervision of qualified instructors. The pupils will be staying in dormitories in accommodation in the centre.

#### **Proposed Itinerary**

Pupils would leave school at 9.30am on the Friday and drive to Carlton Village using school mini buses. Upon arrival, pupils will meet Carlton staff, store bags in their accommodation block and then be kitted out with any necessary equipment. Pupils are issued with a waterproof coat and trousers, wellies and a rucksack. In the morning, the pupils will tackle a team building activity and then in the afternoon head into a local forest for a den building challenge.

After an active day, pupils will enjoy an evening meal which is served in the dining room at the centre. In the evening, pupils will go for a short walk up Captain Cook's Monument and have some free time to play football or rounders on the field.

On the Saturday, pupils will tackle the high wire challenge and have the opportunity to conquer their fears and make the leap of faith! After a packed lunch, pupils will head for their 'weaseling' challenge! On Saturday evening, the pupils will have the opportunity to burst balloons in an archery session which is again based within the centre.

On Sunday, pupils will have a wilderness walk and use a Kelly kettle to boil water and make a hot chocolate to have with their lunch. Once kit has been cleaned and pupils have packed, we will return to school for approximately 2pm.

The cost of the trip will be approximately £160. To secure our booking a deposit of £50 would be needed by Friday 16 November. Payment is by BACS transfer to the school bank, please use the following information:
