KIT LIST

- Passport and European Health Insurance Card
- Full Red House kit including: school skirt/shorts, playing shirt (rugby and hockey), socks, tour training top, school tracksuit bottoms
- Hockey stick, shin pads and gum shields must be included by all hockey players
- Trainers suitable for hockey or netball playing surface and boots suitable to play rugby in (moulded studs for 3G pitch)
- Shoes suitable for activities including laser quest and tobogganing
- Suitable casual wear for free time and for the MasterClass Disco
- Nightwear and wash bag with toiletries
- Towel and swimsuit for the waterpark
- Warm coat, waterproof jacket or coat and a jumper
- Water bottle and sunscreen
- Snacks and drinks for the coach journey (no energy drinks)
- You may want to bring a pillow and a blanket for the coach journey to make it as comfortable as possible

LUGGAGE

All players will be provided with a Canterbury rucksack which must be brought on the tour.

If you need to bring another bag please ensure that it is a small carry bag as space will be limited on the coach.

MONEY

As previously stated pupils will not need to bring a lot of spending money as all food is included when we get to the hotel. We recommend about 20 to 30 Euros spending money per day which should be given to a member of staff in a sealed envelope prior to departing.

This will then be signed out by pupils when required. Pupils will also need to bring around £30 for food and refreshments on the coach journey to and from Dover.

MEDICAL

Please put any medication into a clear plastic bag with the pupil's name on it. Mr Kitching will be in charge of first aid during the tour.

CODE OF CONDUCT

A code of conduct is in place to ensure that all pupils understand the expectations of them as ambassadors of Red House School. Whilst we do not anticipate any problems to arise, we do need to highlight that their actions in extreme cases will have consequences:

- Pupils will be required to check their rooms for any existing damage and to report any inconsistencies to Mr Thorogood immediately on the day of arrival
- Access by teachers to pupils' rooms is to be available at all times
- Pupils will be made aware of when rooms are to be locked and kept un-locked.
- Pupils will be made aware of the hotel rules at the start of the tour
- Pupils will be made aware of exits and emergency procedures in the event of fire
- Clear instructions will be given regarding times for going to rooms and 'lights out'
- Where the reception is not staffed 24 hours a day, security arrangements are in force to stop unauthorised visitors
- Pupils will be required to move around in at least 3's and will be discouraged from travelling in large groups.
