**Five Day Language Tour to Andalucia: Saturday 28 March – Wednesday 1 April 2020**

It is with great enthusiasm that we can reveal the destination of our next Spanish adventure! We propose the striking architecture, elegant art nouveau and dynamic museums of the coast of Andalucia. Your child will get the opportunity to develop his/her language skills whilst being immersed into the Spanish way of life and culture.

This trip will take place during the first week of the Easter holidays from Saturday the 28 March 2020 to Wednesday the 1 April 2020. We will fly from Newcastle airport direct to Malaga. A coach will pick us up from Red House School and take us to the airport. Times will be confirmed at a later date. We will be staying in a hotel in Malaga.

During the visit your son daughter will get the chance to visit some very interesting and famous sites in and around Malaga including:

- "La Alcazaba" – which is a palatial fortification dating back to the 11<sup>th</sup> century.
- Malaga Castle
- The "Rosaleda" stadium – which is the current home of Malaga FC and previously Deportova.
- The "Benalmedena cable car" – this is a 4-man cable car taking you on a 15-minute journey which provides amazing views over the Mediterranean and over the Sierra Nevada. At the top we can see a bird of prey demonstration and the Spanish horses.
- Tivoli World – an exciting selection of thrilling rides are available in this popular theme park, a highlight of many pupils.
- A Catamaran trip leaving from Malaga harbour to take in the beautiful coastline.
- Time to relax with games on the beach and shopping in the small streets in the centre.
- The Picasso Museum – Malaga is where Picasso was born and this museum is home to 285 of his works.

I am sure you can appreciate that this will be an educational roller coaster ride not to be missed which will be the beginning or confirmation of your child's love affair with the country and its culture. It will bring their school studies to life and give them a real reason to continue to work hard.

The cost of the trip, including transport, accommodation, all meals, all entrance fees and insurance will be £700. The only additional costs would be your child's meals whilst travelling between the UK and Spain and their pocket money for gifts, soft drinks and little treats. The

hotel also asks for a €20 damage deposit which will be refunded at the end of the trip, as long as no damage is incurred.
