Year 2 Trip to Captain Cook's Birthplace Museum: Thursday 21 November

As part of our history topic about the life of Captain Cook, Year 2 will be visiting the Birthplace Museum, Marton. The purpose of the visit is to learn about the life of Captain Cook and how his explorations have influenced British history. The children will have the opportunity to combine history with an element of literacy, drama and art as they scribe, handle replica tools and act out scenes depicting life on-board a ship.

We will be travelling by school minibuses and will be leaving school at 8.50am and we will return to School at approximately 3pm.

The day will consist of a guided tour of the museum in the morning and then activities in the Discovery Centre in the afternoon. The children should wear their school tracksuit bottoms, hoody, and trainers. They should also bring a waterproof coat.

The trip will be subject to the conditions set out in the Parent Contract and will be covered by the school's insurance policy. Staff will take a first aid kit with them and there are additional first aid facilities on site. If your child suffers from asthma or severe allergic reactions please ensure their inhaler/medication/epipen is with them. If they do not have them, they will be unable to go on the trip.

The cost of the trip is £5, which will be added to your fee account.
