Dear Parents

Ski trip Madonna di Campiglio: Parents meeting 4pm, Monday 2 December 2019.

It isn't long before we head for the slopes on the annual ski trip. I would like to invite you to a brief meeting to discuss the logistics of the trip, what pupils can expect while they are away and what the school expects from pupils. The meeting will be held in the school hall at 4pm on Monday 2 December and pupils are welcome to attend too. I would anticipate the meeting lasting about an hour.

To speed up administration, I would be grateful if you could bring your child's passport and EHI card so we can photocopy and return them. (Pupils will still need to bring the original documents with them on the trip!). Could I ask that you complete the reply slip below, indicating if you are able to attend and return it by Friday 29 November.

Skiing fashion is also very important and the ski trip hoodies will be in school the week before we depart. We have managed to secure a deal with our tour company who have kindly subsidised the cost of these hoodies meaning the cost to pupils is only £15. In order to keep administration to a minimum, this will be added to the terms fee bill.

Questions have already been asked about clothing. For skiing, pupils should take the following:

- Ski jacket
- Salopettes (ski trousers)
- Ski gloves
- Ski goggles
- Ski socks (2 pairs, but only 1 pair worn at a time)
- Velcro ski ties (to help identify individuals' ski's.)
- Lip balm
- Sun screen

Ski-wear is well insulated so pupils will not need anything bulky to wear underneath. Usually a light jumper, or even a t-shirt is adequate, combined with leggings or similar.

Casual wear is the theme for evenings, with jeans, t-shirts and jumpers being all that is needed. Pupils should also take a warm hat to wear around the village, and also take substantial footwear suitable for the (hopefully) snowy conditions. Pupils will need toiletries and a towel. Pupils should be encouraged to pack light as the hotel accommodation is over three floors and they will have to carry their own cases up and down the stairs.
