World Book Day: Thursday 5 March 2020

Pupils at the Junior School will be celebrating World Book Day on Thursday 5 March. This year's theme is 'History books'. The children in each year group will have already read lots of books as part of their history topic work but we hope to share some of these stories as this is World Book Day's theme, 'Share a Million Stories'. We will be doing this throughout the day with as much fun and interactivity as possible because the joy of reading is a lifelong passion.

Each year group has chosen a period of history which their class will study. The children can dress up in the costumes from that era or as a character from that period.

- Nursery & Reception have chosen to look at Kings and Queens throughout history. They can dress up as princes, princesses, kings and queens.
- Year 1 have chosen the Victorians and so they could perhaps come in the costumes they used for their school trip to Ormesby Hall?
- Year 2 will be studying 'Captain Cook' so can come dressed as anybody from this period.
- Year 3 will be looking at the Viking sagas and since they have already made their costumes as part of their Design and Technology topic they will be wearing those for World Book Day.
- Year 4 are currently studying 'The Aztecs' so they can dress up as an Aztec or Mexican.

Pupils will need suitable footwear and their outdoor coat, gloves and hat for break time.

We hope that each child will be able to make a donation of £2 towards the World Book Day Charity: Book Aid International which sends books to children in Africa.
