Dear Parents

We have now finalised our plans for the pastoral meetings for Years 7-9. These have been arranged following the guidelines of no more than 15 pupils from any year group being in school at any one time.

The meeting will be an opportunity for the pupils to reconnect with the children in their tutor group, discuss how they have been during their absence from school and to alleviate any concerns about returning in September.

The pupils will be having a socially distanced gathering and food will be provided. We hope the weather is kind to us and the pupils can have a picnic outside. If this is not the case, the pupils will meet in the sports hall.

The pupils should wear casual clothing and should not arrive more than five minutes before the published time. We have marks on the floor by the main entrance and the pupils should line up here, after sanitising their hands (sanitisers are available at all entrances).

We would also like the pupils to bring all their textbooks into school in a carrier bag, marked with their name. We will then 'quarantine' the books before storing them ready for the next class in September. Please ask the pupils to ensure all books are returned to avoid charges being levied. Class teachers have been made aware of this plan and, therefore, textbooks will not be required for work next week.

Please ensure the pupils leave the site promptly once they have been dismissed.
