Year 2 Trip to Captain Cook's Birthplace Museum: Wednesday 17 November

As part of our history topic about the life of Captain Cook, Year 2 will be visiting the Birthplace Museum, Marton. The purpose of the visit is to learn about the life of Captain Cook and how his explorations have influenced British history. The children will have the opportunity to combine history with an element of literacy, drama and art, as they scribe, handle replica tools and act out scenes depicting life on-board a ship.

We will be travelling by minibus and will be leaving school at 9.30am. We will return to school at approximately 3.15pm.

The day will consist of a guided tour of the museum in the morning and then activities in the Discovery Centre in the afternoon. The children should wear their school P.E kit including hoody and bring a waterproof jacket.

Pupils are expected to demonstrate excellent behaviour at all times and to follow instructions.

Pupils are covered under the School's insurance policy. A full risk assessment has been undertaken by the group leaders.

Mrs Cooper will lead the trip and will be assisted by 2 other members of staff. A qualified first aider will be accompanying the trip.

The cost of the trip is £5 which will be added to next term's school fees.
